# First Circular

The next annual meeting of UISPP 4<sup>th</sup> Commission (Data Management and Mathematical Methods in Archaeology) is scheduled for 5-6 June 2009, Budapest.

## Venue

Hungarian National Museum, Budapest, H-1088 Budapest, Múzeum krt. 14-16. The main field of interest of the conference is '*Quantitative Methods for the Challenges in 21<sup>st</sup> Century Archaeology'*.

## Objectives

Modern archaeology has to cope with tasks beyond scholarly pottering. Excavations on industrial scale and vast amount of finds and evidences are ahead of us to save and preserve for the future and create adequate analysis for the present.

Quantitative methods can help in forecasting, handling and investigating the archaeological heritage. Predictive modelling can help us to find - or avoid - potential sites, assessing the 'archaeological hazard'. Sampling techniques and statistical methods can help in deriving useful and reliable information from masses of potential data. Information technology solutions can support the storage and retrieval of the large amount of data collected that should be made accessible and known for the professionals as well as the wide public.

The 4<sup>th</sup> Commission of U.I.S.P.P. plans to address these challenging problems on the next meeting scheduled June 2009 in Budapest, hosted by the Hungarian National Museum.

## Presentations

Contributions are accepted as oral or poster presentations. As regards the form, the intention of the authors is a primary factor; however, the organisers may suggest changes due to limitations in time. Confirmation of attendance is needed for both oral and poster presentations: at least one of the authors must be present on the Conference for acceptance in program and abstract volume. The time allotted for each oral presentation is 20 minutes, including discussion, introductory and closing arguments.

We are expecting to have scholarly papers on various aspects of quantitative methods in the field of archaeology and cultural heritage. We have received a positive reply on our First Call for Papers by several authors. The final program will be compiled after registration.
