Sarmizegetusa Regia (III.-I. BC) was the most important Dacian religious, military and politically center. On the plateau from Sarmizegetusa Regia (near Hunedoara) is the sacred zone, which contains more circular and rectangular sanctuaries and the Andesite Sun. We will present the Andesite Sun from Sarmizegetusa Regia and our results about the ten solar radius on the top of the sun altar.
