Obsidian finds in Croatia

- Small number
- At least half of them without of stratigraphical context
- No previous analysis
- Two major area of finds:
 - **Continental** (Northern) part of Croatia
 - **Coastal** (Southern) part of Croatia

- Vinkovci – Pjeskana
- Vinkovci – Hotel
- Sopot
- Samatovci (analysed by Katalin T. Biró)
- Herrmann's winery
- Čepin (Ovčara) – OHA02
- Franjin Dvor – OHA04

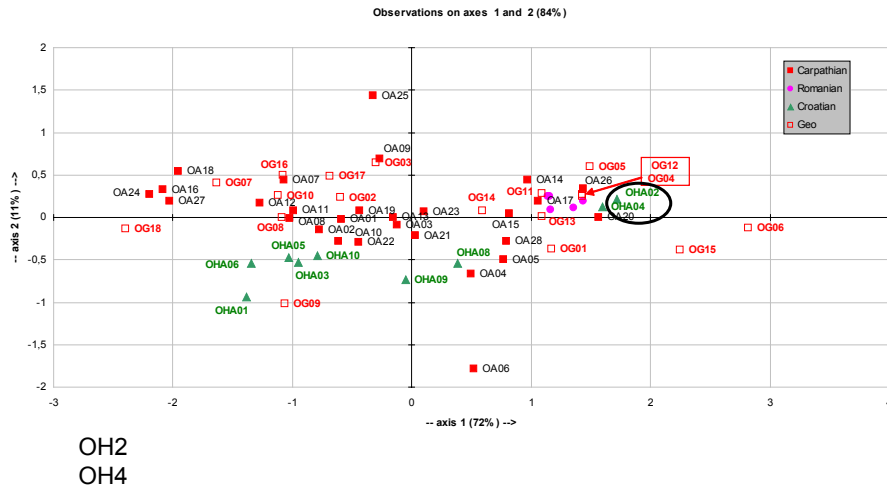


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PGAA results = Carp I

- Smilčić (vicinity of Zadar) – OHA06
- Đevrske (vicinity of Zadar) – OHA05
- Danilo (vicinity of Šibenik) – OHA03
- Vela Spila (Korčula island) – OHA01
- Marko's cave (Hvar Island)
- several sites in Istria - Kargadur (so far cca 30 samples) distribution or working center?

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- Đevrske (vicinity of Zadar) – OHA05
- Danilo (vicinity of Šibenik) – OHA03
- Vela Spila (Korčula island) – OHA01 (Tykot)
- Sušac (island) – OH09; OH10 (Tykot)

PGAA results = Mediterranean source

Vela Spila & Sušac – proven as Liparian origin
